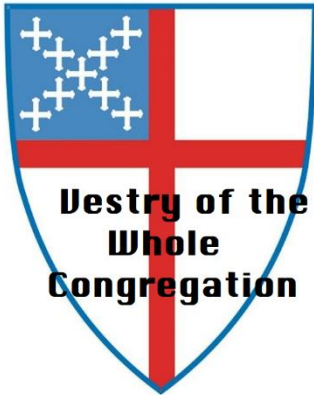

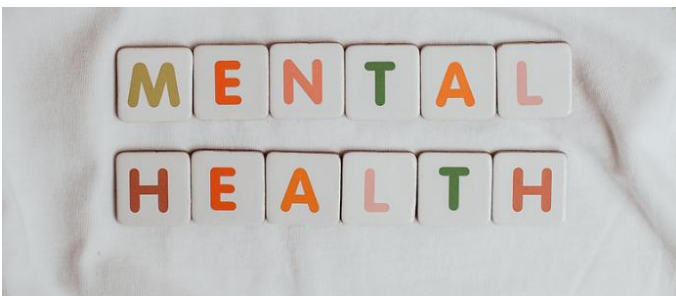


NO VESTRY OF THE WHOLE MEETING IN JUNE
