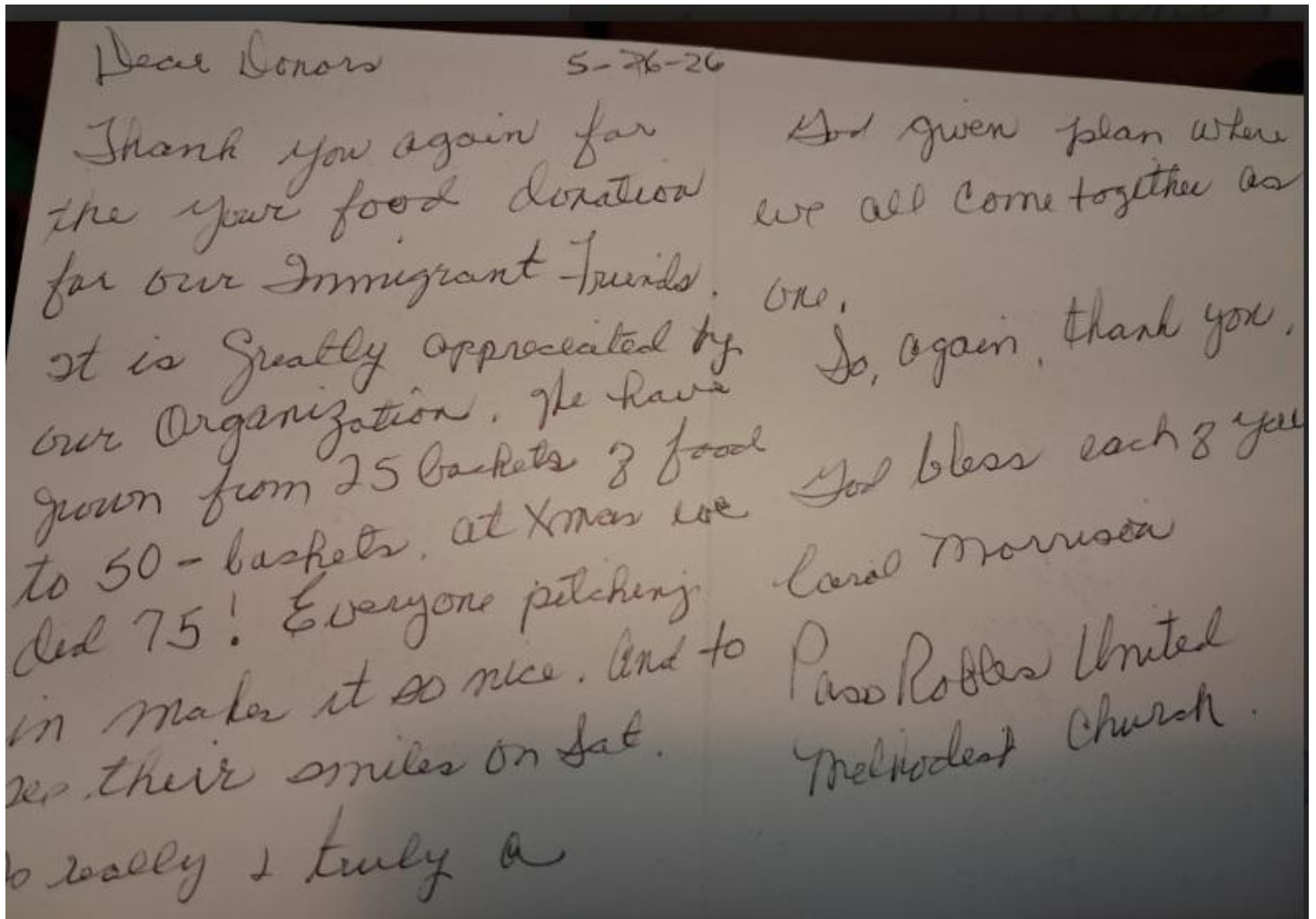

THE BIDDING BOOK & PRAYER REQUESTS

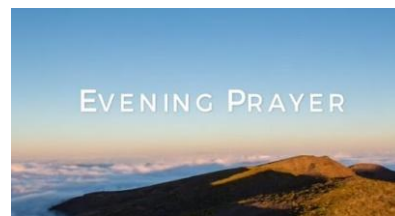
